- **This permit is nontransferable.**
- The applicant assumes all **responsibility** of injury, damage, and loss as a result of this mooring permit.
- In the event of a failure of the permit holder to comply with the terms and conditions of this authorization and fails to correct such non-compliance within a reasonable period after verbal or written notification from the Harbormaster Department, this permit may be suspended, modified or revoked in whole or in part without liability to the Town of Duxbury.
- This permit shall expire on the last day of the calendar year in which it was issued.
